

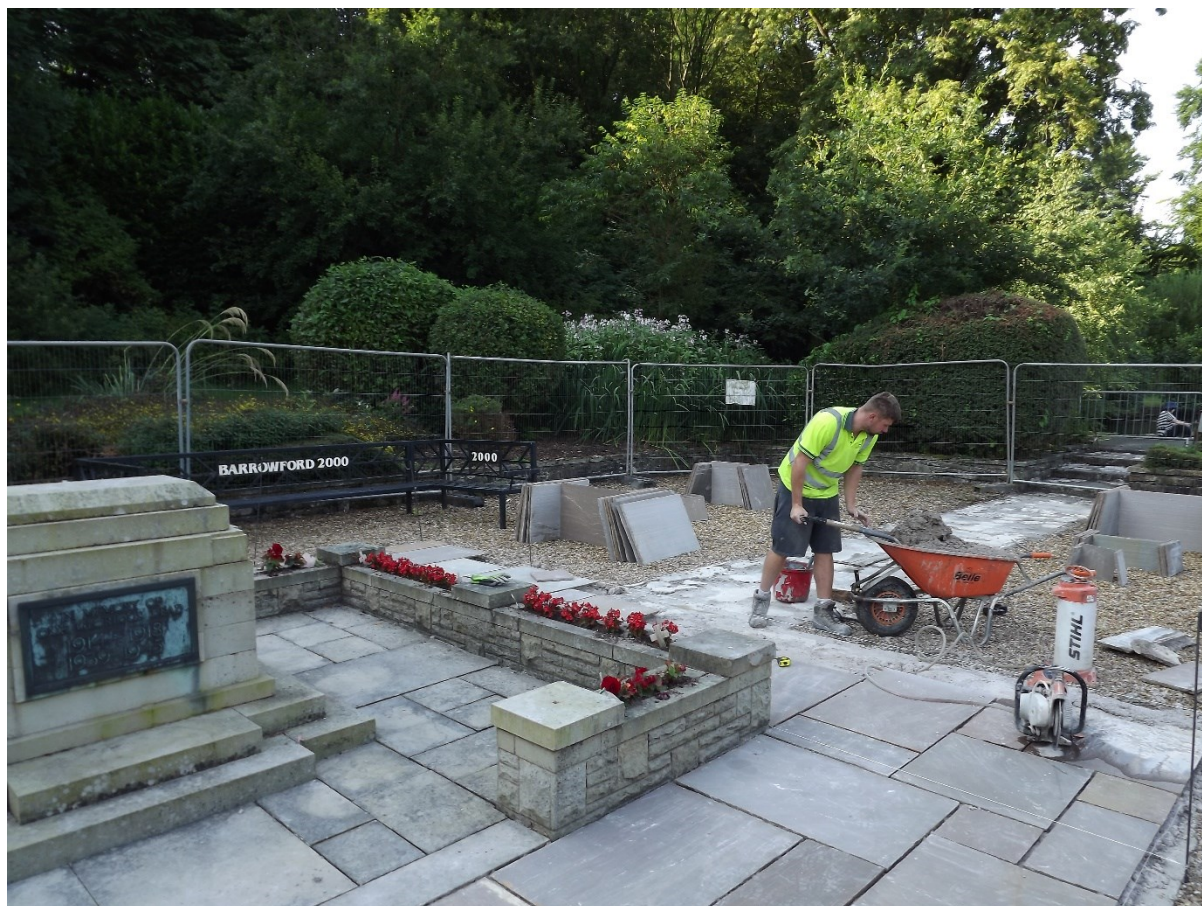

#### **Refurbishment of the Memorial Garden:**

Work started on the re-flagging of the Memorial Garden on the 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2024 a site meeting was held on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> August and the work was almost completed with the work expected to be finished on the 12<sup>th</sup> August. #### **Additional Names for the Memorial:**

Cllr. Lewis and the Clerk have come up with this list of names to be added to the War Memorial: The WW1 Memorial has enough room to add the 11 new names and the plaque has been removed from the memorial to carry out this work. A new plaque is to be ordered to accommodate servicemen from other conflicts and the three additions for WW2. The Clerk has asked the Rev P. Payton to come up with a suitable epitaph as the new Vicar of St Thomas's may not be in post in time to enable the plaque to be made in time for Remembrance Sunday. The Clerk will report progress at the meeting.

**George Aldersley**, Army Service Corps, DM2/162289, died 10 September 1917, King George's Hospital, London

**Harold Ashworth**, "A" Battery 122<sup>nd</sup> Brigade, Royal Field Artillery, 1607, died 30 April 1918, Brandehoeck New Military Cemetery, Belgium.

**John Robert Barlow**, Able Seaman, Royal Navy, J/75456, died 15<sup>th</sup> February, 1919, Scapa Flow St Margaret's Hope, Orkney, Scotland

**Alexander Milburn Craig**, "D" Battery 170<sup>th</sup> Brigade Royal Field Artillery, 18554, died 12 August 1917 Buried Roclincourt Military Cemetery France.

**Harold England**, Private, Royal Marine Light Infantry, Ply/589(S), died 13<sup>th</sup> November 1916.

**Wilfred Holt**, Second Lieutenant, Manchester Regiment, died 16<sup>th</sup> August 1917, Belgium

**William Louis Knowles**, Pioneer, Royal Engineers, 30223, 302236 died 14 March 1919, Barrowford, United Kingdom

**James William Meanock**, Private, Lancashire Fusiliers/Royal Defence Corps, 6416, died 24<sup>th</sup> November 1918, Barrowford, United Kingdom

**Herbert Pollitt**, Royal Field Artillery 31<sup>st</sup> Division Ammunition Column, L/18146, died 11 November 1918 Kezelberg Military Cemetery, Belgium

**Harold Speak**, Air Mechanic 3<sup>rd</sup> Class, Royal Air Force, 220030, died 28<sup>th</sup> October 1918, Lincoln Hospital, United Kingdom

**James Leonard Roberts**, Private, Lancashire Fusiliers, 5476, died 18<sup>th</sup> December 1914, South Hospital Bristol, United Kingdom.

### **The Inter War Period (1919-1938)**

**Thomas Kirk**, Acting/Lance Corporal, Durham Light Infantry 113423 died 1<sup>st</sup> January 1920, Cologne Germany.

### **The Second World War (1939-1945)**

**Royal Ashworth**, 73<sup>rd</sup> Company Auxiliary Military Pioneer Corps, 113007657, died 17 June 1940 following sinking of HMS Lancastria. Commemorated Pornic War Cemetery France.

**Bertie Pate**, Able Seaman, Royal Navy, D/JX 257960, died 15th June 1944, H.M.S Mourne Commemorated Plymouth Naval Memorial, England.

**Albert Shea**, Gunner, 11(Honourable Artillery Company) Royal Horse Artillery, 984184, died 24 January 1942, Commemorated Alamein Memorial, Egypt.

### **Post-War (1945-Present)**

**Anthony J. Maher**, Lance Corporal, King's Own Royal Border Regiment, died 13 August 1987, United Kingdom Buried at All Souls Catholic Cemetery, Barrowford.

**Paul Sutcliffe**, Private, Ulster Defence Regiment, died 1<sup>st</sup> March 1991, Mullaghcreevie, Northern Ireland
